

Strathpine station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2020

The Strathpine station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

The following activities were undertaken at Strathpine in December:

- ongoing entry and landscaping works
- ongoing lift installation
- ongoing bicycle enclosure works
- western carpark lighting installation
- platform resurfacing works
- removal of decommissioned ramp – platform 2/3.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- opening of the new lifts (Monday 20 January)
- reopening of upgraded platform 2/3 and closure of temporary platform (Monday 20 January)
- eastern entry and landscaping works
- bicycle enclosure fit-out
- footbridge flooring works (Saturday 1 February)
- stormwater drainage works – platform 2/3.

Please follow all directional signage and take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.
