

# Night works Banyo station



## What?

To facilitate Energex works as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake underboring activities on selected nights in March 2024.

Night works include excavation, underboring (tunnelling) and concrete pumping.



## When?

From 9pm until 5am the next day on:

- Tuesday 5 to Thursday 7 March
- Sunday 10 to Friday 15 March
- Sunday 17 to Thursday 21 March.

Where possible, noisiest activities will be scheduled earlier in the evening.



## Where?

Works will occur in the vicinity of the St Vincent's Road level crossing at the corner of St Vincent's Road, Tufnell Road and Royal Parade east (near the Banyo station carpark) and footpath areas adjacent to the station precinct.



## Impacts



Operation of vacuum excavators, and concrete pumping trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Night works



Lane closures and traffic management



Construction noise, the use of concrete saw cutters, tunnelling equipment, concrete pumps, powered tools and machinery



Lighting towers at night
