WORKS NOTICE

Night works (rescheduled) – temporary footbridge installation

Wednesday 22 and Thursday 23 August 2018

Installation of Strathpine station's temporary footbridge, originally planned for Sunday 19 August, has been **rescheduled to Thursday 23 August, between 10.30pm and 4am** the next day. This is a continuation of night works previously notified for **Wednesday 22 August**.

Queensland Rail apologises for this late change to the program, resulting from emergency works elsewhere on the network on Sunday night.

For the safety of customers and project workers, these works must be carried out outside of peak services or after hours when there is no rail traffic and power to the overhead lines is switched off. Nearby residents may experience some noise from the use of cranes, truck movements and construction activity at night. Portable lighting towers will also be in use.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. Queensland Rail appreciates your cooperation during these important works.
