### **ELIMBAH STABLING FACILITY**

The South East Queensland (SEQ) Rail Stabling Program involves the construction of four purpose built train stabling facilities in various parts of the rail network to support the expansion of the rail fleet that will begin next year. One of these new facilities will be built at Elimbah.

The other sites that are part of this program are Banyo, Robina and Woombye. A fifth stabling facility is being constructed at Kippa-Ring, as part of the Moreton Bay Rail project.

Queensland Rail has been given responsibility for the construction and operation of these stabling facilities and want to ensure that the community is provided with timely and relevant project information.

We undertook a doorknock of your area today and you were not home. To ensure you stay informed, we have provided a project fact sheet. It details the next stage of design and construction for the Elimbah stabling facility and includes answers to frequently asked questions about stabling. We have also included our contact card.
