ROBINA STABLING FACILITY

The South East Queensland (SEQ) Rail Stabling Program involves the construction of purpose built, modern train stabling facilities across the rail network to support more passenger services. As part of this project, the existing Robina stabling facility, located adjacent to the train station, will be extended to accommodate four six-car trains.

Queensland Rail has been given responsibility for the construction and management of the additional stabling facilities. We want to ensure that the community in which we are constructing the facility is provided with timely and relevant project information.

Early works and site establishment will start this month and will include potholing, fencing and compound set-up. Construction will start in September 2015 and will be complete by January 2016. We anticipate the facility to be operational by February 2016.
