BANYO STABLING FACILITY

The South East Queensland (SEQ) Rail Stabling Program involves the construction of four new, purpose built train stabling facilities to support the expansion of the rail fleet that will begin next year. One of these facilities will be constructed at Banyo to house four trains when these are not in service. The other sites are Elimbah, Robina and Woombye. A fifth facility is being constructed at Kippa-Ring as part of the Moreton Bay Rail project.

Queensland Rail has been given responsibility for the construction and operation of these stabling facilities and we want to ensure that the community is provided with timely and relevant project information.

An informal drop-in information session on 13 June will be an opportunity to meet the Queensland Rail project team, gain an understanding of what the stabling facility will look like and what will occur there, as well as to discuss project design and construction timelines and ask questions.
