



## Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade

Project update - October 2024

The Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's plan to expand, improve and modernise the South East Queensland rail network.

We're excited to be getting underway with important works to restore the original station building, an iconic feature of the local community, back to its 1914 footprint. Improvements will also be made to the station to make it more accessible and easier for our customers to use.

Queensland Rail recently released a tender to refurbish the almost 130-year-old station, with works to commence in 2025.

## **Project progress**

More than 400 objects of heritage significance were discovered in the subfloor of the old station building, including train tickets, clothing, newspaper and bottles – some dating back to the 1890s. A 1940s sailor's cap, unearthed in the dig, was even reunited with its owner's family seven-decades later – just one example of the delicate care, precision and attention Queensland Rail has been giving to this historic upgrade.

Since then, the Shorncliffe community have provided input into the project through community consultation, feedback and engagement sessions.

The project recently reached a significant milestone with the issue of a tender to design and construct on 5 August 2024. Following the successful appointment of a contractor in early 2025, a works program will be developed to determine construction timeframes. Construction is expected to be completed by early 2026.
