

Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – DECEMBER 2025

The Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's plan to improve and modernise the South East Queensland rail network.

Project progress

Shorncliffe station temporarily closed to train services and customers on Saturday 29 November. All services on the Shorncliffe line will now terminate at Sandgate station until the station reopens in mid-2026.

Restoration activities have already commenced with the removal of timber walls from the station buildings. These, along with other timber elements including heritage windows and doors, will be gently restored and prepared for placement back in the building over the coming months.

The recent scheduled weekend closure of the Shorncliffe line allowed us to remove the building that acted as our temporary ticket office in recent years.

Alternative transport

Shuttle bus R346 is operating in a loop between Sandgate and Shorncliffe stations, and will stop at five additional bus stops across the Shorncliffe area.

The shuttle service is accessible and runs every 15 minutes during peak, and connects with arriving trains at Sandgate station during off-peak.

Upcoming works

Over the coming weeks you can expect to see the following activities underway:

- the heritage station buildings will be temporarily relocated into the station carpark to enable building structural carpentry works
- the 1980's concrete slab roof of the air raid shelter will be removed and scaffolding put in place to support the building while structural investigations are carried out
- civil stormwater works will occur in the carpark and in the sub floor area of the building
- concrete works for improved footpaths and bike locker relocation.

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday**, unless otherwise advised.

The team will take a break over the holiday period between Thursday 25 December 2025 and Friday 2 January 2026.
