

Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JULY 2025

The Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's plan to improve and modernise the South East Queensland rail network.

Project progress

Queensland Rail is pleased to advise that in late April, construction company, Degnan, was awarded the Design and Construct Principal Contract to deliver this important station renewal project and accessibility upgrade.

Queensland Rail has partnered with Degnan on many projects and we look forward to working with them again at Shorncliffe station.

The works program will now be developed to determine construction timeframes. We expect works to get underway in late 2025.

About the project

The Shorncliffe station building renewal project focuses on restoring the original station building back to its 1914 footprint, to preserve its heritage within the local area and for future generations, while improving station infrastructure to provide easier access to public transport.

Next steps

Queensland Rail will keep the community and customers informed of travel and construction impacts as plans progress.

Key project features

Shorncliffe station accessibility features will include:

- 90m high-level platform raising at the accessible boarding point
- upgraded hearing augmentation loops and tactile ground surface indicators
- upgraded security cameras and lighting
- new wayfinding and platform signage
- construction of a new accessible station entrance ramp
- construction of two new platform seats
- new accessible ticket window, toilet and facilities.

Station restoration works will include:

- restoration of the old station building back to its 1914 original footprint
- restoration of the existing awning.
