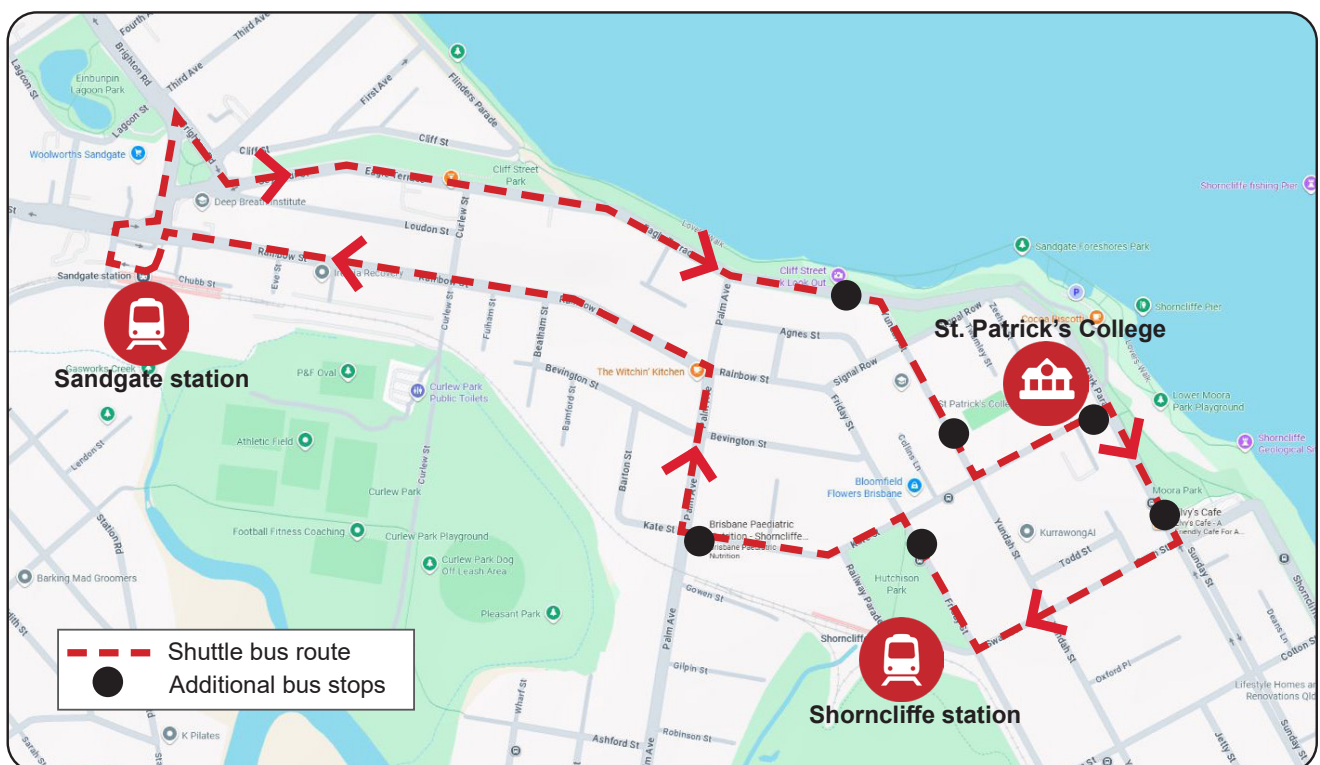
Keeping you connected to public transport

To deliver this important project as safely as possible, the station will close from Saturday 29 November 2025. Customers can look forward to the station reopening in mid-2026.

During the station closure, trains on the Shorncliffe line will terminate at Sandgate station. A shuttle bus will operate in a loop between Shorncliffe and Sandgate stations, with services matching the train schedule. Each service will take approximately 10-15 minutes to complete one loop.

Shuttle bus service information

- Peak hour services every 15 minutes - 5:30am to 10am and 3pm to 8pm
- Off peak services every 30 minutes
- For the convenience of the Shorncliffe community, the shuttle bus will also stop at some existing Brisbane City Council bus stops along the loop (see map below)
- In addition, dedicated shuttle buses will operate before and after school between Sandgate station and St Patrick's College, Shorncliffe.



Upcoming works

You can expect to see activity at the station from mid-October as the contractor establishes the construction site compound in the station carpark. The station and the carpark will be closed to the public from Saturday 29 November.

Works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.
