WORKS NOTICE

Night and weekend works

Early-December 2021

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works in **early-December** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, these works have been scheduled over weekends when rail traffic does not service platform 1 and customers cannot access the platform. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

A single lane closure will be in place on Tribune Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works occurring over weekends (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.

Tribune Street, South Brisbane (single lane closure)	From 11.59pm Friday 3 to 4.30am Monday 6 December	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Single lane closure between Grey and Colchester Streets.Northbound detour via Ernest Street and Colchester Street.Southbound detour via Stanley Street, Annerley Road, Stephens Road, Vulture Street, Ernest Street and Colchester Street.
