

Wacol station refresh

October – November 2017

Queensland Rail is undertaking minor upgrades at 10 locations across the Citytrain network to improve amenities and provide cleaner, safer stations for our customers. As part of the 'Fixing the trains' action plan, Wacol station is undergoing a refresh during October and November 2017.

The works will include minor platform improvements, landscaping, signage and an industrial clean. During this period, temporary amenities may be in place while improvement works are undertaken to the existing toilets. Customers may also need to use alternative access points at times during the works.
