

# Woombye stabling facility

## Fleet storage

November 2018

Queensland Rail would like to update the Woombye community on the use of its stabling facility as we transition towards full operations.

From late-November, Queensland Rail will use the Woombye stabling facility to store older trains not in service, as a temporary measure.

When the older trains are stabled in the facility, they will be turned off. NGR trains may still be stabled in the facility at times with power on, ahead of the final testing required to enter full revenue service, however they will remain in stabling mode to minimise noise.

There is not expected to be any activity during the night as the trains are not yet in service and are not required to be cleaned. The lights will continue to operate at a low level, unless triggered by movement in the facility.

The Woombye stabling facility is not expected to be fully operational until 2019, when trains will be stored overnight and cleaned on a daily basis.

Queensland Rail will continue to keep the community updated.
