



Update: maintenance work Albert Bridge, Indooroopilly

Queensland Rail is working to carry out essential cleaning and painting on the Albert Rail Bridge in Indooroopilly to maintain and rehabilitate its steel components and improve its reliability and operational safety.

We took on board feedback from local residents and revised our work over the Christmas period, to minimise impacts to your community. This is a continuation of work which began on Thursday 24 December 2015.

Queensland Rail is aware noise and lighting from such operations can cause temporary inconvenience to our valued neighbours. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption.

Overview of maintenance work

Location	Dates and hours of work	Type of work
Albert Bridge between Indooroopilly and Chelmer	From 6am on Saturday 9 until 6pm on Sunday 10 January Continuous work	Continuation of the assembly of scaffolding on a section of the Albert Bridge and also underneath the bridge. This will involve simple hand tools and light power tools (including hammers, saws, chain tongs, drills and chainsaws). A light crane with reversing beepers will be used to assemble the scaffolding. Residents may notice some vehicle movements, however noise will be kept to a minimum.
