Coomera to Helensvale Duplication

Wednesday 6 July to May 2017

Bridge construction in Coomera River and Saltwater Creek

Queensland Rail would like to advise of changed conditions in Coomera River and Saltwater Creek due to construction of the Coomera to Helensvale Duplication project.

From Wednesday 6 July 2016, marine works will commence as part of construction of the duplicated rail bridge that crosses Coomera River, Hope Island Road and Saltwater Creek.

Users of Coomera River and Saltwater Creek are advised to take care and follow navigation directions around the work zones.

Works in Coomera River and Saltwater Creek are expected to be completed in May 2017, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Coomera River

Initial works in Coomera River will include removing vegetation and installing temporary working platforms. Barge operations and piling works will commence in early August 2016 and continue until May 2017.

An appropriate navigation channel in Coomera River near the rail bridge will be maintained at all times.

Saltwater Creek

Works in Saltwater Creek will include installing temporary working platforms on both sides of the creek to enable the operation of piling rigs, cranes and other machinery, as well as installing bridge piers and structures.

The navigation channel in Saltwater Creek near the rail bridge will be maintained at 12 metres wide at all times.
