Merivale Bridge maintenance works

Queensland Rail is undertaking essential maintenance works on the Merivale Bridge over the Brisbane River. The bridge is a vital transport link in South East Queensland, serving as Brisbane's only inner-city river rail crossing.

Upcoming activities for this project include the erection of scaffolding to facilitate cleaning and painting of the bridge arch and cables as well as transom (sleeper) replacement across the bridge deck, re-railing, permanent stair access and walkways. In addition to regular works (6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday), the following night works are scheduled in April.
