

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Night works – May/June 2016

As part of the Nambour station accessibility upgrade, **demolition and piling works** will occur **nightly** from **Saturday 21 May to Friday 3 June 2016**, between the hours of **7pm and 5am** (the next morning).

Works will include the demolition of platform structures and part of the station building, as well as screw piling works.
