

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Piling works – July 2016

Queensland Rail recognises that the current construction activities associated with the Nambour station upgrade may cause inconvenience to the local community.

Businesses and residents adjacent to the station precinct may experience noise and ground vibrations from **excavation and piling works**.

Works include the delivery and installation of steel sheet piles, as a soil retention system, prior to the excavation and removal of spoil to construct the new lift shaft.

Piling works are being undertaken during normal **daytime working hours, 7am to 5pm**, and will continue **daily until Saturday 16 July 2016**. Piling represents approximately 30 percent of daytime construction activities.

Every effort is being made to minimise disruption during works.
