

North Johnstone River bridge remediation works

March 2016

Queensland Rail is undertaking remediation works on the North Johnstone River rail bridge on the North Coast line, approximately one kilometre south of Daradgee. The remediation works are necessary to ensure safe, timely and adequate rail services continue to be provided to the North Coast line between Townsville and Cairns.

Upcoming activities planned for March 2016 are listed in the table below.

Works will generally occur between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless specified (for example, scheduled night works).
