



Sadliers Crossing bridge upgrade Scheduled works – late July/early August

Queensland Rail is replacing a series of rail bridges on the Ipswich to Rosewood line, in South East Queensland. Under this program, ageing timber bridges will be replaced with steel and concrete structures to improve reliability, operational safety and efficiency of services on the rail corridor.

Upcoming activities for this project include a temporary road closure prior and after hours works during a planned track closure over the weekend of 1-2 August 2015.

This work involves the use of heavy, loud machinery associated with piling works.

Nearby residents may experience some noise from truck movements and construction activity, and will see cranes and lighting during night activities.
