



## SEQ timber bridge replacement Walloon scheduled works – January/February 2016

Queensland Rail is replacing a series of ageing timber rail bridges on the Ipswich to Rosewood line, in South East Queensland, to improve reliability, operational safety and efficiency of services on the rail corridor.

Works are progressing with bridge replacements at Guilfoyles Gully and Karrabin scheduled during a planned track closure on 16-17 January 2016.

To facilitate these works, an additional work area will be established to dismantle the old timber bridge spans once they have been removed from the bridge sites. This additional work area is opposite contractor JF Hull's present site office in Railway Street, adjacent to the Walloon station, on the southern side of the rail line.

Upcoming local activities are detailed in the table below.

JF Hull will also be demobilising the Railway Street site office in February 2016, weather and construction conditions permitting. More information will be provided in January 2016.
