Nerang Power Equipment Room Project

Project Introduction - April 2024

Project information

Queensland Rail will deliver a new Power Equipment Room (PER) at Nerang station. The project will begin in April and is expected to be completed in December 2024. General works will involve electrical cabling to set up the new infrastructure, construction work to remove and replace the retaining wall, installation of temporary lighting and fencing, partial carpark changes, line marking works and commissioning works to test the new PER.

General work hours

Works will be commencing on **Saturday 6 April 2024**, and over the course of the project are scheduled to occur between **6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday**, as well as during planned track closures.

Upcoming after hours works and impacts

Some after hours work will be occurring in April. During this time, nearby residents and customers may experience:

- an increase in construction and machinery noise
- increased dust in the vicinity of works
- an increase in vehicles and trucks with flashing lights and reversing beepers in the area
- partial closures of the Nerang station carpark (managed by traffic control).

Works will be occurring between:

- 6am and 6pm on Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 April (scheduled track closure)
- 6am and 6pm, each day between Monday 8 and Sunday 14 April
- 6pm and 6am, each night between Monday 15 and Sunday 21 April.

Advance notice will be provided for construction activities likely to cause additional impacts, including any after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
