

Burnett River Bridge repainting project

September 2023

Queensland Rail is repainting the Burnett River Bridge as part of an assets renewal program.

Contractor, Eptec Services, established a presence on site in August, prior to the commencement of works which occurred on Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 August 2023.

The project involves cleaning, sandblasting and repainting the bridge structure. Scaffolding is currently being erected around the bridge to provide safe working platforms.

Queensland Rail and Eptec Services' working hours are now 8am to 5pm Monday to Sunday, or during scheduled track closures (around-the-clock works). Sunday work will commence from Sunday 10 September.

Nearby residents may experience noise associated with construction activities and an increase in project vehicles in the vicinity of the rail bridge and site compounds.

Project site compounds have been established on Queensland Rail property at either end of the bridge. These areas will be used for staff amenities and as laydown facilities for the storage of machinery equipment and materials.

Activities will continue on the Burnett River Bridge until approximately mid-2025.

Advance notice will be given to nearby residents if project activities are likely to cause impacts, including night works.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. We thank you for your understanding as we undertake these important works.
