## Entertainment and Hospitality

### Our Commitment

Queensland Rail recognizes that appropriate corporate entertainment and hospitality can provide legitimate commercial benefits for the organization but the nature of such expenditure means it must be modest and undertaken with the requisite probity, financial restraint, transparency and accountability. Queensland Rail is committed to complying with its legal obligations, adhering to applicable government policies and acting in accordance with the expectations of our responsible Ministers in relation to such expenditure.

### What we will do

To deliver on this commitment, we will:

- exercise appropriate restraint in respect of expenditure on entertainment and hospitality;
- follow directions of responsible Ministers in relation to such expenditure;
- ensure all expenditure on entertainment and hospitality is reasonable, with clearly identifiable commercial or organisational benefits, and is otherwise able to withstand public scrutiny;
- ensure that expenditure on entertainment and hospitality is directed to achieving the best social, economic and environmental outcomes;
- clearly articulate our expectations in relation to expenditure on entertainment and hospitality to our personnel;
- pursue the optimum value-for-money outcomes at all times;
- avoid any actual or perceived conflict of interest in relation to such expenditure; and
- provide accurate reports to responsible Ministers in relation to amounts expended on entertainment and hospitality.
